- Decking material is heat reflective, made of High-Density Polyethylene (HDPE) with fiberglass and a proprietary mixture of additives, rated for ground contact and underwater installation, structural and spans 24" on center.

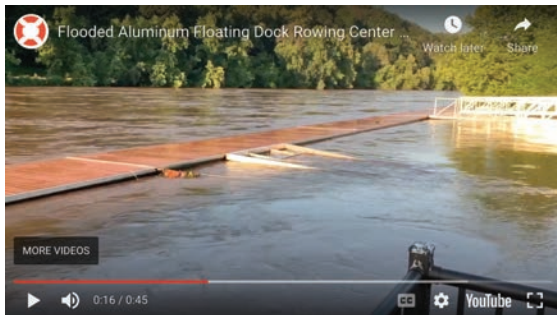

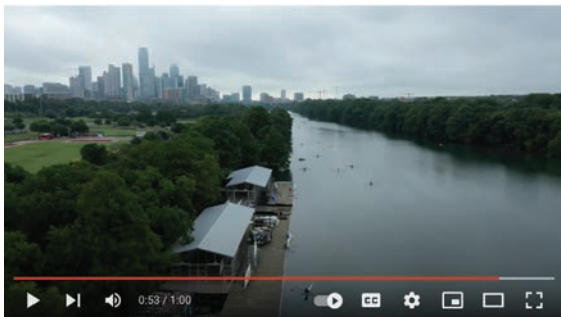

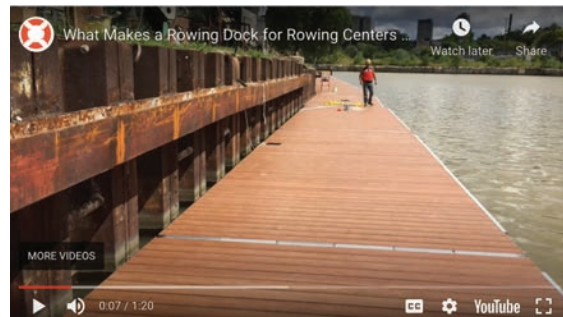
